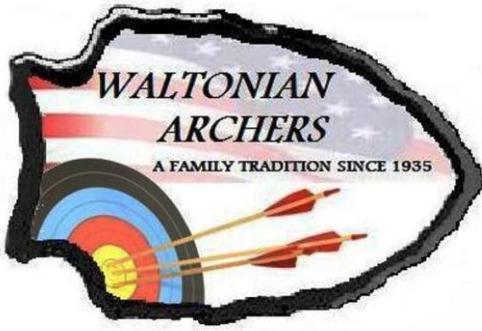

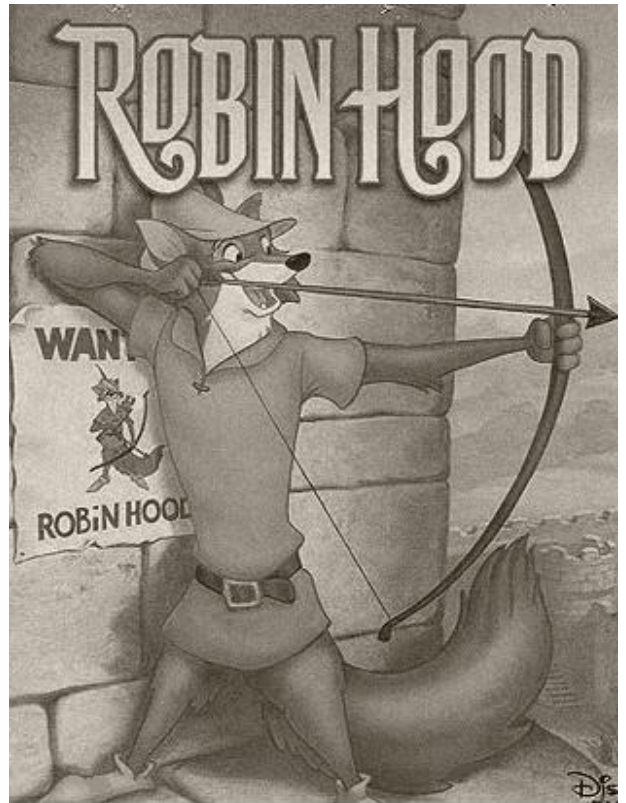
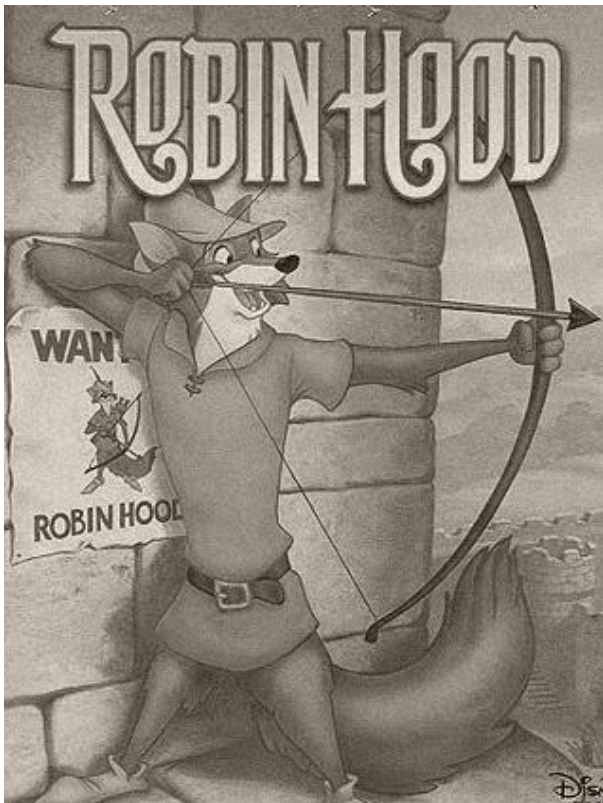


ARCHERY FUNNIES
