While setting up for the Art Foster traditional shoot several of the members were using machines that Marv Findley had procured for the club. These really make the heavy work of moving 3D targets easier. Thanks Marv for your help in getting the machines for the club!

For members who have never shot a clout or candlelight shoot these will take place on September 16th. The clout is designed to be like an old English clout shoot. The men shoot at a distance of 180 yards, the women 120 yards and the kids 11 and under shoot at 80 yards. You shoot six ends of six arrows each for a score plus two practice ends at a flag pole with a cable attached to it representing a target face on the ground. The candlelight shoot is designed after a raccoon hunter shooting at night. You go on the course after dark with a flashlight and one arrow. If you lose it or break it you are done but must stay with your group until the end of the course. We shoot 14 targets. These two shoots are only for fun and bragging rights.
