- c. Mowing of the flats
- d. Mowing of the Pavilion area
- e. Clearing of down trees in the entire club grounds
- f. Painting of the markers used as shooting positions throughout the club grounds
- g. Repair of bridges on the ranges
- h. Repair of bridges to enter and exit the courses
- i. Maintain roads on the entire grounds
- j. Repair of the buildings
- k. Assist in the kitchen during events
- l. Setup courses for shooting events
- m. Clean and repaint building as needed
- n. Serve as a shoot chairman
- o. Serve as a committee member for different projects
- p. Serve as an officer of the club
- q. Repairs inside the clubhouse during different events
- r. Repairs of the shooting butts inside
- s. Occasional repair to fences that surround our club
- t. Equipment repairs, a constant need for a small engine person
