1941 On April 28th of this year the Articles of Incorporation were written the club had 47 members. There were 12 instructors at the playground this year. Tournaments were planned and a committee was set up for each. The club offered a \$10.00 reward for anyone caught and convicted of shooting on the game preserve this was paid out only once (they meant it when they said no guns) 1942 Each member had to make a target to certain specifications or be fined \$3.00 (Dues plus \$1.00). There were contests in the early days and each member made his own equipment as well as equipment for the club and there were prizes given for the best job and the best design. This year the practice was started whereby all new members were on probation for 30 days with shooting privileges only after which he was either voted in or out. Bob and Agnes Lindsey joined the club this year.
