





Project Day

We have a project day coming up this Saturday, March 31st. We have projects identified that we need to work on. We generally start about 8 am and work as long as a person wishes. Lunch is provided. Any amount of time that you can help would be appreciated. The projects that we need to work on are cleaning up the ranges of branches, fallen trees or other issues on the range. Another project is cleaning out the creek bed on the white range. We also have a lot of Maple saplings that have been cut to keep the oaks healthy. We need to either pile these up in brush piles or pull them out of the range. If anyone has a chainsaw there are more maple saplings that need to be cleared out. Any saplings 6 inches diameter and under need to be cut. The white range is the range on your right as you drive into the club. We also need to build some steps on the Orange range. There is a steep hill on this range. We'll probably use railroad ties. Need a little muscle here. We have a few log bridges that need to be repaired and finally we need to get that Garlic Mustard sprayed with Roundup. So come on out Saturday and let's see how far along we can get. We won't get everything done in one day, but we can put a huge dent in it. Heck, with enough people we may get it all done!

Club Dues


Club dues of \$50.00 for the 2007 year need to be paid to Club Treasurer Randy Beelner (395-7492)
