## Safety Note:

Due to safety concerns the big tree stand at the top of the hill is closed until repairs are made.

## To-Do List:

The following is a list of a few of the items that need to be worked on out at the club:

- Cut down any small smooth barked saplings, 6 inches or less thick. These are the small maples that the conservation officer has told us should be cut down to prevent eventual shading out of the oaks and other hardwoods. The White and Orange ranges are the main areas to concentrate on for now.
- Course maintenance will need to be started. Walk the courses and see if there are any targets that need to be raked and mowed.
- Cleaning up wood piles. Any wood that can be used as fire wood should be stacked at the bottom of the pines. Wood piles to the right of the road are for trees that have been downed for a time. Wood piles to the left of the road are from trees recently cut.

Be sure to check the board in the outdoor pavilion area for a complete list of items that need to be completed.
