The club was formed in April of this year led by Fred Enders. The charter members were Warren Hartman, Fred Enders, John Kohls, and Don Seegers and with the help of the local Isaac Walton league (only the name is retained although there is no connection with them). Some of the other members were W H Linders, Jack Dysart, Russ Graham, Paul Samos, Charles Murray, Miles Fisher, Peck Hogland, Don Meyers, and Mary Newland. There were twenty-three members in the club, seven of which were women. There were no permanent records kept the first few years and the by-laws were lost and were rewritten. The meetings were held twice a month in the member's homes. Club officers were elected in December of this year. There was \$6.31 in the club treasury.
