## Update on Conservation, Range Restoration and Tree Planting

We would like to update members on the continuing work to restore the ranges from the Derecho damage. The DNR District Forester has shown us three areas where we will be working to replant trees. Two are on the orange range. One is around targets six and seven east of the gully and the other is around targets eight and eleven west of the gully. These areas need to be completely clear so the new trees are not shaded out. He marked some additional small trees and saplings which we have removed. Several of us have been working on these areas to clear brush, cut weeds and take down the marked trees. We have ordered 100 seed-lings from the State Forest Nursery with 25 each of red oak, white oak, walnut and hickory. They will be picked up in April and we have planned to have a planting weekend on April 15 and 16 if weather permits. The trees will be protected from wildlife browsing with tubes or wire cages and stakes. The ground will be mulched in a 3 foot circle around them to suppress weeds. The tubes are translucent to allow sunlight to get to the seedlings and will be in place three to five years. They need to be blocked up each fall to keep mice from nesting in them and girdling the seedlings.

There is also a larger area at the top of the blue range around the shooting stand that is being prepped to be planted in 2024 or 2025. You will see trees up there marked with orange paint by the forester to be removed similar to what happened on the orange range. There will have to be significant ground preparation as well because of the extent of the damage in the area. We have been working on target number 4 blue to open it up and get access to the upper loop of the blue range. We hope to be able to set some targets up there this summer.


