On November 9th Carl Mally, Bob Schell and Dennis Ringgenberg split a piece of hickory to make bow staves. This was from a Derecho downed tree on the white range, too bent and broken for the loggers to use, that had been cut to open up a shooting spot. The log was a little over six feet long and about 14 inches in diameter. It split nicely into eight pieces for self bow staves using a maul and wedges. The ends were sealed and the staves put in the rafters of the machine shed to dry for two years. At that time they can then be carved into long bows.
