Hunters donated 4,183 deer hides to Elks Lodges across lowa last year, which was a slight increase from the 2021 -22 season. The deer hides are used by the Veterans Leather Program to make professionally-crafted leather gloves for veterans in wheelchairs and also turned into leather used for therapy programs for recovering veterans.

The Veterans Leather Program relies on the charity of hunters to donate their deer hides.
