### The difference between NASP and JOAD

NASP stands for National Archery in the Schools Program and is a joint venture between state Departments of Education and Natural Resources. The program is generally taught in the schools during a two week PE course which includes form, equipment and safety while allowing kids to try the sport of Archery. The program began in Kentucky in 2002 with the training of 39 educators and 22 middle school pilot projects. Last year the National Tournament in Louisville KY brought roughly 7,000 kids together to shoot over one week end in May. Currently, the Alburnett Archery in the School Team meets Saturday mornings at the Waltonians to practice for the State tournament which will be held in Des Moines during the Deer Classic in late February. Last year they were 3<sup>rd</sup> in the State High School division and hope to bring home the top award this year. The Alburnett Archery team has qualified for the National NASP Tournament in each of the last 3 years and has used the Waltonian facilities to prepare for that competition.

JOAD (also an acronym) stands for Junior Olympic Archery Development and is affiliated with USA Archery. JOAD is open to any youth archer aged 8 to 20 regardless of what school they attend. Both recurve and compound bows are used in club activities and in tournaments. JOAD archers who use a compound bow can train to compete in local regional and national tournaments, and can earn a seat on a youth world team to compete in other countries representing the United States on behalf of USA Archery. Recurve archers can compete likewise, with the added benefit of being able to use their recurve bow to try out for a spot on the US Olympic Archery team which is selected and managed by USA Archery. The Wapsi Warriors JOAD club was created in 2010 and meets at the Waltonians Thursday nights all year long from 5 to 6:30. Any youth archers interested in joining JOAD can come out and talk to the coaches. Wapsi Warriors JOAD club members and their families typically join the Waltonian Archers and participate on a variety of levels, making them vital members of the club.

So basically both NASP and JOAD are ways for youth to be introduced to archery and continue toward a lifetime of shooting. Both groups would like to thank the Waltonian Archers for the use of the facilities and the support received over the last several years.
